Deuteronomy 6:1-6

- 1 “Now this is the commandment—the statutes and the rules—that the Lord your God commanded me to teach you, that you may do them in the land to which you are going over, to possess it,
- 2 that you may fear the Lord your God, you and your son and your son’s son, by keeping all his statutes and his commandments, which I command you, all the days of your life, and that your days may be long.
- 3 Hear therefore, O Israel, and be careful to do them, that it may go well with you, and that you may multiply greatly, as the Lord, the God of your fathers, has promised you, in a land flowing with milk and honey.
- 4 “Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one.
- 5 You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might.
- 6 And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart.

Luke 17:5-10

- 5 The apostles said to the Lord, “Increase our faith!”
- 6 And the Lord said, “If you had faith like a grain of mustard seed, you could say to this mulberry tree, ‘Be uprooted and planted in the sea,’ and it would obey you.
- 7 “Will any one of you who has a servant plowing or keeping sheep say to him when he has come in from the field, ‘Come at once and recline at table’?
- 8 Will he not rather say to him, ‘Prepare supper for me, and dress properly, and serve me while I eat and drink, and afterward you will eat and drink’?
- 9 Does he thank the servant because he did what was commanded?
- 10 So you also, when you have done all that you were commanded, say, ‘We are unworthy servants; we have only done what was our duty.’”

1.) The ASK v. 5, “The apostles said to the Lord, “Increase our faith!”

2.) The EXPECTATION v. 7, “Will any one of you who has a servant plowing or keeping sheep say to him when he has come in from the field, ‘Come at once and recline at table’?”

3.) The DUTY v. 10(b), “We have only done what was our duty.”



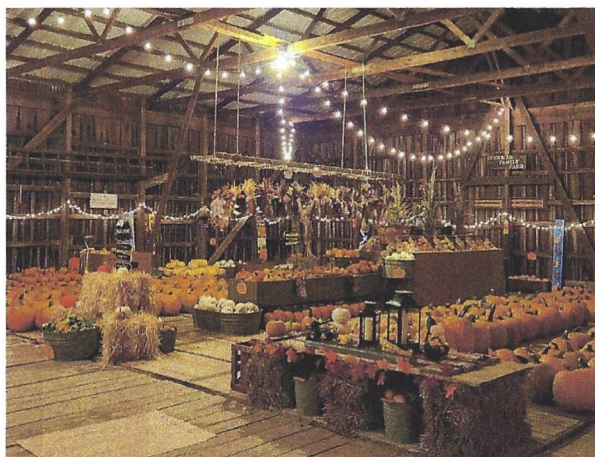
